Some Definitions:

- 1. A **guardian** is appointed by the court to make the **personal decisions** for the person subject to guardianship. The guardian has authority to make decisions on behalf of the protected person about such things as where to live, medical decisions, training and education, etc. (mncourts.gov)
- 2. **Supported decision-making** is often defined as supports and services that help an adult with a disability make his or her own decisions by relying on trusted friends, family members, professionals, and others. (americanbar.org)
